Personal Data

Personal data is relating to any information that can be identifiable to a person.

Personal Data Collected

All personal data will be collected with permission by the form of verbal or electronical means (email, messages, forms, verbally). This data will be available to Animals in Action Veterinary Physiotherapy and consent form your veterinary practice with relevant veterinary history will be obtained by law. A report may be sent to your Veterinary Surgeon after the physiotherapy session.

Why do you need personal data?

Personal information will be used to identify the client and patient to the Veterinary Surgeon this includes your name, pets name, email address, contact number, home address and other essential details. It allows effective communication between owners, your Veterinary surgeon and myself. It is also required by the insurance (Balens ltd) and the NAVP to obtain detailed records in order to maintain the standards set by the professional organisations.

Data retention

Data will be stored in a locked file, and password protected computer/ Ipad for 7 years as required by the insurance (Balens Itd) and NAVP, after which it will be appropriately destroyed.

Your rights

As an individual, you have the legal rights to understand the use of your personal data, as detailed above. You can request copies, amend data if incorrect, and place restrictions on its processing. You also have the right to request deletion of your personal data.
